- **Complete required subcontractor outreach (the system tells you status). If you are new to the process, read the guides and FAQ's on the site. If you have a question, ask.**
- **Complete the outreach summary sheet by the due date**
- **Contractors – don't forget to watch for RFQ's for on-call lists. Some have missed opportunities because they were in the habit of only looking for bids.**
