#### MAJOR MAINTENANCE




#### **Major Maintenance Projects...**

preserve or recondition a facility for its intended use;

<u>repair</u> or <u>replace</u> building systems and components







- Responsible for Renovation / Repairs
- Typically 200-300 active projects at any given time worth ~\$200M
  - Projects range from \$50K \$30M
- Typical Duration MM project is: 6 Months – 2 Years
- JOC / CMAR are the primary delivery methods
  - \$25-\$30M annually in JOC



### CAPITAL

#### **Capital Projects...**

<u>construct new facilities;</u> may include demolition of an existing facility; and may include a land purchase







### CAPITAL





- Current active volume (project value): \$500M
- Typical duration: 3+ years (program through construction)
- Planning underway for ~ \$375M

 Sheriff HQ – Mechanical Systems Renovation CMAR -\$10M

#### **Feb/March 2020:**

- HHSA North Central Regional Center Renovation CMAR - \$8M
- George Bailey Detention Facility Integrated Electronic Security CMAR - \$25M

- San Marcos Fleet Garage Renovation CMAR \$ TBD (\$7.5M project value)
- Ramona HHSA Live Well Center DB \$ TBD (\$12M project value)
