



High-Speed Fully Electric Rail Travel Between Southern California and Las Vegas Federally permitted & shovel ready


LAS VEGAS - VICTOR VALLEY PROJECT

- 170-mile corridor of protected track, mostly in median of I-15
 - No grade crossings
 - Mostly single track
- High-speed, fully electric trains running up to 180 MPH
 - 85-minute travel times, with 25 trains in each direction per day
- At full operations, expect to capture 11 million one-way trips annually
- Vast Community Benefits:
 - Convenient, affordable and flexible travel-option
 - Equivalent to +3 million cars taken off the road per year
 - 30,000 construction jobs and 1,000 permanent jobs
 - Supportive of multi-modal travel across California






Rail Alignment – Victor Valley to Las Vegas







Rail Alignment – Apple Valley to Barstow

Rail Alignment – North of Baker to State Line






Rail Alignment – Nevada





Station and Facilities – Apple Valley

- ~300-acre site:
 - 150 acres for surface parking
 - 75 acres for stations and maintenance facility
 - Development will be incorporated into parking areas over time.






Station – Las Vegas

 - ~10 acres for stations and maintenance facility
 - Development will be incorporated into parking areas over time.
