preserve or renovate a facility for its intended use;

repair or replace building systems and components

# MAJOR WAINTENANCE



















- Responsible for Renovation / Repairs
- Typically 200-300 active projects at any given time worth ~\$300M
  - Projects range from \$50K \$65M
- Typical Duration MM project is:
   6 Months 2 Years
- JOC / CMAR are the primary delivery methods
  - \$25-\$30M annually in JOC

# CAPITAL


### **Capital Projects...**

construct new facilities; may include demolition of an existing facility; and may include a land purchase





# CAPITAL



 Current active volume (project value): \$700M

 Typical duration: 3+ years (programming thru construction)

Planning underway for ~ \$500M+
