
Interactive GIS Map








JOC Procurement for 2021

A-E Qualified Vendor List (QVL)


QVL

- Each discipline will generate a Qualified Vendors List (QVL)
- \$200,000 contract(s) per agency per year per firm

On-Call Contracts

- Based on projected usage, a select number of firms will be awarded larger On-Call Contracts
- \$500,000 to \$2.5M contracts, varies by discipline
- 3-year terms with the option to renew for an additional 2 years
- Number of On-Call Contracts awarded varies by projected usage





A-E Slate Renewals

CM/Inspection

- Awarded on 11/17/20
- Contracts expire November 2023 with option to renew until November 2025
- 10 contracts, \$600,000 each
- 26 firms on the QVL list

Geotechnical/Materials Testing

- Awarded on 12/15/20
- Contracts expire December 2022
- 5 contracts, \$500,000 each
- 18 firms on the QVL list


