I-405 Improvement Project



Scope:

- Two new lanes stretching 16 miles each direction
 - One regular lane
 - Creation of 405 Express Lanes
- 18 bridge replacements
- Improvements to local streets and interchanges
- \$2.08 billion total cost
- Six-year, design-build contract

Status:

- More than halfway complete overall
- Six bridge replacements complete
- 2023: Anticipated completion





OC Streetcar









Scope:


 4.1 miles connecting Santa Ana transportation center to Harbor Boulevard in Garden Grove

Benefits:

 Improves air quality, eases congestion, offers high-frequency transit, enhances transit connectivity

Status:

2023: Operations scheduled to begin



I-5 South County Improvements





Status:

- SR-73 to Oso Pkwy: January 2020 to mid-2025
- Oso Pkwy to Alicia Pkwy: April 2019 to late-2023
- Alicia Pkwy to El Toro Rd: January 2021 to late-2024


Scope:

- Adds regular lane between Avery & Alicia parkways
- Extends second carpool lane between Alicia Parkway and El Toro Road
- Improves interchanges, an overcrossing, on- and off-ramps and auxiliary lanes



SR-55 Improvements (I-405 to I-5) A 30 YEARS







Status:

2022: Start of construction

2026: Anticipated completion

Scope:

- Adds one regular lane in each direction
- Adds second carpool lane in each direction
- Adds auxiliary lanes

Measure M Overview




Measure M2 (OC Go): 2011-41

- Renewed by voters in 2006 for 30 years
- Began collection in 2011
- Leveraged \$3.5 billion to date in external revenues


Measure M1: 1991-2011

- Successful implementation
- Delivered more than \$4 billion in transportation improvements
- Leveraged \$1.2 billion in external revenues

Next 10 Delivery Plan (2021-30)



Streets

- Returns 18% to local agencies for transportation needs
- Provides annual grants to address bottlenecks
- Funds ongoing coordination of 2,200 traffic signals



Environmental

- Ensures ongoing preservation of open space properties
- Provides annual grants for water cleanup projects

 Maintains Metrolink service and improves rail stations

Begins operation of OC Streetcar


- Enhances mobility options for seniors and persons with disabilities
- Continues support for localized transit options

- 14 freeway projects to be delivered in the Next 10 Plan timeframe
- Four remaining Measure M freeway projects to be reassessed during annual review






