


LASAN's Clean Water Program

- Sewer System Length: 6,700 Miles





•Goals

- •1.5 mgd for LAX and HWRP
- Proof of concept
- •Treatment: MBR RO UV/AOP
- Project Partners: LADWP and LAWA
- •\$92 million progressive design build contract with LSBE (Local Small Business Enterprise)








Rendering of future site





Hyperion 2035

- Projected design and construction cost ~\$4 billion (conceptual estimate)
- Currently looking at 3 phases plus enabling projects but each with many "packages"
 - Phase 1 tentatively planned to begin in 2024 or 2025





Contract Types

- Personal Services Contracts (RFP)
- Performance of professional, scientific, expert or technical services of a temporary and occasional nature for specific projects
- On Call Contracts (RFQ)
- For the development of a pre-qualified list of contractors for project implementation
- **Sole Source Contracts**
- Technical proprietary expertise available from only one source




What to Expect

- Be flexible Expect Change


Process Differs Among City Departments
