On Tuesday, April 12, the Inglewood City Council approved the Final Environmental Impact Report and related entitlements for the Inglewood Transit Connector (ITC). This official seal of approval marks a significant step toward connecting the City of Inglewood to region-wide transit while providing a critical link that allows Inglewood residents an opportunity to travel throughout LA County for jobs, schools, and more. When completed, the ITC will provide a critical first-last mile connection between the Metro K-Line and Inglewood's top business and entertainment destinations.

The ITC is an approximately 1.6-mile long, three-station, fully elevated, electrically powered automated transit system that will connect Inglewood residents to the expanding LA Metro system. The ITC is also projected to create approximately 500-700 direct construction jobs and over 10,000 indirect jobs throughout the region.
