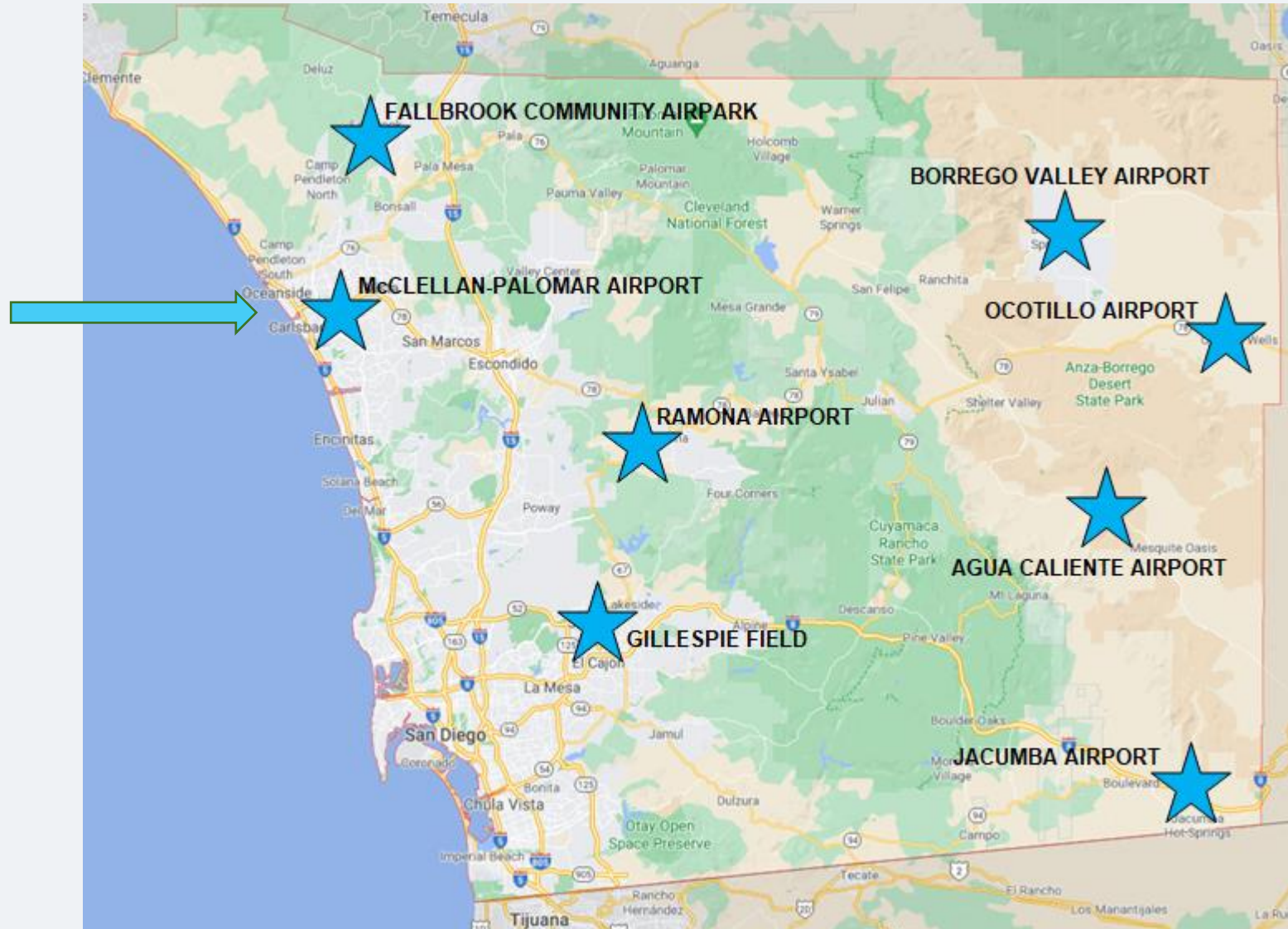

 - EMAS

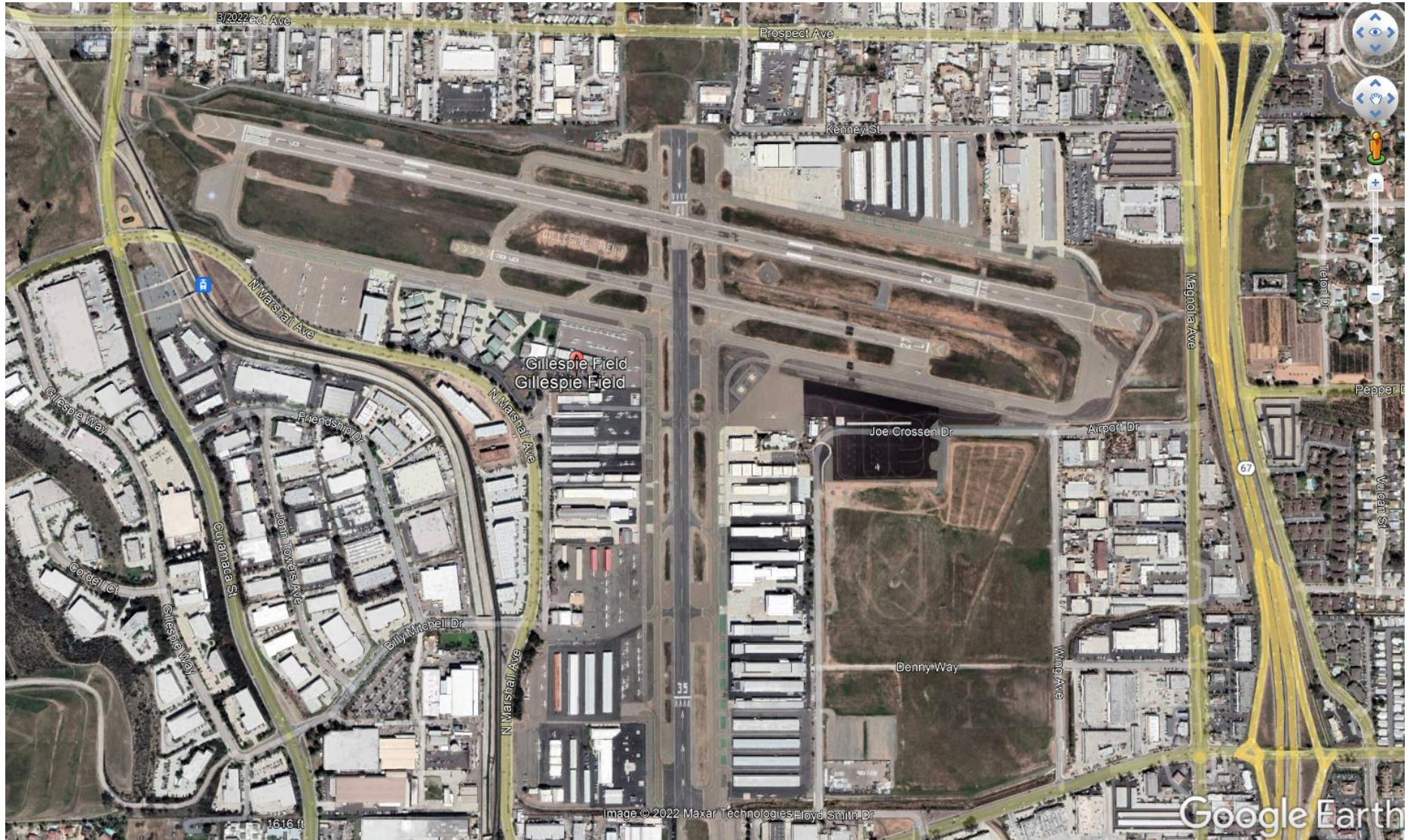

- Construction of Aircraft Rescue & Fire Fighting Building (2026)
