Envisioning a New Terminal 1


When Terminal 1 opened in 1967, it served 2.5 million passengers in its first year. In 2018, the same facility served more than 12 million. For roughly half of our passengers, Terminal 1 provides their first impression of San Diego. We believe we can do better. The Airport Development Plan (ADP) envisions replacing Terminal 1 with a modern facility offering:

- More gate-area seating
- New restaurants and shops
- Additional security checkpoint lanes

The ADP also includes transportation improvements that make getting to the airport easier for everyone. Our ultimate goal is to provide a first-class customer experience and maintain the airport's role as a major economic driver, while serving as a collaborative regional partner. The need for the ADP has been fueled by the tremendous growth seen in passenger totals over the last several years. In fact, SAN is the busiest singlerunway commercial airport in the nation today.



TERMINAL 1 PARKING PLAZA **SWINERTON**

Description: Cast-in-place, five (5) level structure, approximately 2,000,000 SF for 5,230 parking stalls. It will be constructed in two (2) stages. Stage 1 will be 12/23/2022 to 8/01/2024 and Stage 2 will be 12/29/2023 to 5/30/2025.

September 2022 Procurement: Metal Panels, Earthwork

December 2022 Procurement: Masonry, Structural Steel/Misc.
