




About VWD



- District founded in 1955
- Currently serves population of 108,392
- 45 square mile service area (San Marcos, Vista, Carlsbad, Escondido, unincorporated areas)
- 108+ skilled professionals
- Annual operating budget of \$100.2M for FY 22/23
- \$148M 5-Year CIP program
- \$29.7M allocated for FY 22/23





Water & Wastewater Facilities



Water

- 366 miles of water pipes
- 11 pump stations
- 19 reservoirs 120MG of storage
- Approx 27% of District's annual supply is a direct connection to the Desalination Plant in Carlsbad
- 21,700 accounts

Wastewater/Recycled Water

- 275 miles of sewer pipe
- 4 sewer lift stations
- 20,600 accounts
- Can recycle up to 74% of District's wastewater at Meadowlark Water Reclamation Facility (MRF) – 3.5MGD
- Recycle Water Wholesaler: Customers are CMWD and OMWD


