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LA1 RENOVATION

Project Description:

Renovation for the Geography Department and the College of Liberal Arts Advising Center. Creates the Donato Center and renovates offices and computer labs for. The project will also replace all windows, provide fire sprinklers and new fire alarm and other safety upgrades.

Project Status: In Construction

Open: Summer 2023

HILLSIDE NORTH STUDENT HOUSING

Project Description:

New student housing building partially funded thru SB-169 (Affordable Student Housing Grant Program). This will provide approximately 400 new suite-style beds for a more independent style of living focused on the needs of upper-division and mature students.

Affordable Housing Component:

Co-funding of this project through SB-169 will allow an equal number of affordable beds (approx. 400) to be distributed throughout all of the campus' housing offerings – allowing for students at all levels to access the type of housing best suited to their situation.


