Recently Completed Projects

McCarthy Hall - \$40M

Renovation, enhancement and upgrade to the 2nd floor. Project included construction and design of student collaboration areas and informal learning spaces, as well as completion of required code upgrades.

Baseball/Softball Facilities - \$15M

Renovation of existing building and construction of new building. Project included design and construction of locker rooms, showers, coaches' offices, and other spaces for both baseball and softball teams. Additionally, new construction addressed accessibility and emergency vehicle access.

Student Housing Phase 4 - \$123M

Built a 6-story, 600-bed student housing complex that includes graduate and staff apartments, lounges, multi-purpose rooms, and campus support function spaces.

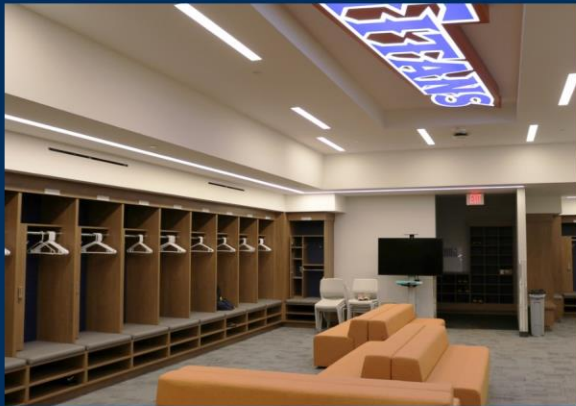
KHS Pool Replacement - \$8M

Removed and replaced existing two pools with one Olympic-sized 50 meter pool. Moveable bulkhead allows for a variety of programming, including men's and women's water polo.

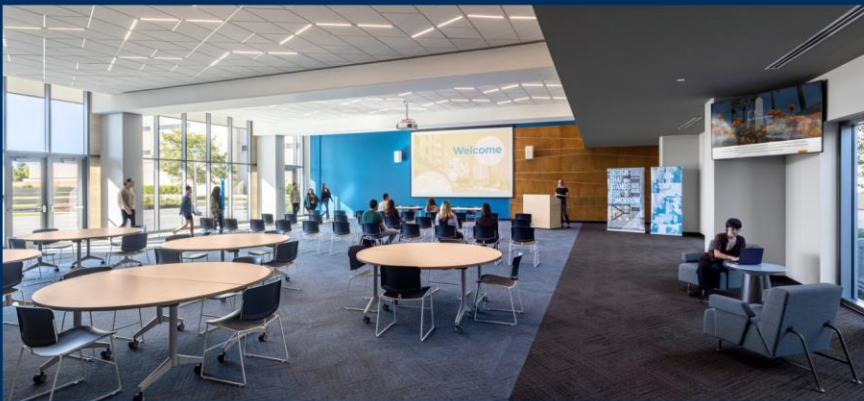
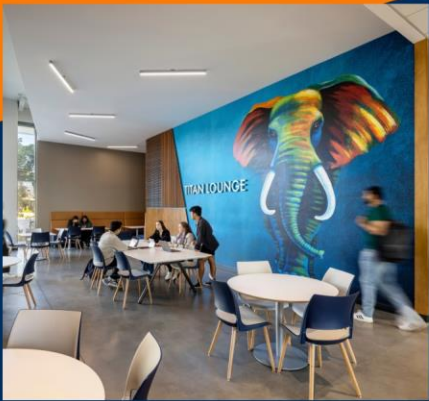
