#### NORTH COUNTY TRANSIT DISTRICT

### **NCTD** Is A Multi-Modal Operator



#### **BREEZE** buses

20,749 average weekday boardings

6.4 million annual boardings

152 buses cover 30 routes



#### **COASTER trains**

4,886 average weekday boardings

1.4 million annual boardings

7 locomotives and 28 bi-level passenger coaches cover 41-mile route north to south



#### SPRINTER hybrid rail

7,865 average weekday boardings

2.4 million annual boardings

12 DMU trains cover a 22-mile route east to west



LIFT paratransit service uses a variety of ADA-certified vehicles

**FLEX** serves Oceanside to Camp Pendleton (392 and 395) and Escondido to Ramona (371 and 372)

### **Physical Infrastructure Overview**

### Rail Right-of-Way

- 61-mile coastal railroad along with San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS)
- 22-mile railway for light rail service (SPRINTER)

#### Facilities

- 5 operations & maintenance facilities (2 bus, 3 rail)
- 6 transit centers
- 12 SPRINTER stations
- 7 COASTER stations
- 1600+ bus stops
- 2 administrative buildings and other miscellaneous facilities



#### **NORTH COUNTY**

## Capital Improvement Program

- Ten-year program
- Funding from federal grants, state, and local
- **Managed with Project Online**
- Many rail projects executed via San Diego Regional Planning **Authority (SANDAG)**
- **Primarily design-bid-build**
- On call A&E benches



## 5-Year Capital Strategic Priorities

#### Increase Customer Ridership and Revenue

- Implement 30-minute frequencies on the COASTER
- Implement 15-minute peak frequencies on the SPRINTER
- Implement improved BREEZE bus service frequencies
- Implement new first and last mile services

### Improve Service Quality

- Implement new passenger information technologies that improve the customer riding experience
- Improve employee training programs for both direct and contracted employees

### Improve On-Time Performance

- Reduce mechanical failures by advancing bus and rail fleet replacement and completing overhauls/upgrades

### Fund State of Good Repair and Priority Capital Needs

- Advance battery and fuel cell zero-emission bus procurements and facility improvements
- State-of-good-repair bridge and facility projects
