#### **TUMF**

- Provided \$400 million in funding to our members which was leveraged for \$1 billion in improvements
- 112 projects completed and counting since 2003
- 79 more projects in the pipeline with an additional \$375 million in funding over the next 5 years







### TUMF Origins

- In the late 1990's, region was experiencing tremendous growth
- Disputes regarding how to mitigate traffic impacts of new development
- Idea was to collect a regional fee that would support regional infrastructure
- Would supplement existing funding from State & Federal, Measure A Sales Tax, and local funds



# What Kind of Projects Can TUMF Fund?

- Major roadways
- Interchanges
- Bridges
- Railroad grade separations
- Transit centers
- Sidewalks and bicycle paths



## Why Have A Regional Program?

- Traffic does not respect City boundaries
- Local fee programs can only fund projects within that agency
- A uniform fee does not put any jurisdictions at an advantage over others
- Allows a single Nexus Study to be used for consistency purposes



#### How Does TUMF Work?

- WRCOG collects fees from developers
- Funding is split between local funds, RCTC, RCA, and RTA
- Agency staff identifies key projects they would like to receive funding
- Agency staff meet to decide funding allocations
- Approved by elected officials from these agencies
- WRCOG provides reimbursement to member agencies after they incur expenses



## How is the Money Allocated?


- 45.7% to the Zone for local projects
- 45.7% to RCTC for regional projects
- 3% to RTA
- 1.5% to RCA
- 4% to WRCOG



#### **TUMF Zones**

- WRCOG region is divided into 5 areas for purposes of TUMF collection and funding allocation
- Zones
  - Northwest
  - Southwest
  - Central
  - Hemet/San Jacinto
  - Pass







#### Zone TIP

- 5-year funding plan for the Zone TUMF funds
- Each Zone has an adopted TIP
- \$250M+ in committed funding over 5 years
