














## **NT1 Upcoming Traffic Switches**

- Several Traffic Switches will occur in the remainder of 2023
- T2 AAR Entry (complete)
  Reduced to 1-lane in July
  2023 for ~1 year
- "TS2" Stage 1 (complete) Adjusts the T1 AAR entry from Harbor Dr. and the T1 Pedestrian Path, and reduces Harbor Dr. to 3lanes for ~1 month
- "TS2" Stage 2 (Nov 14)
  Permanently shifts the T1
  Recirc. Road and
  T1 Harbor Island Drive
  entry
- T1 Ground Trans. Center Returns to its original position in Dec. 2023


