

SANDAG Advancing Border Connectivity

The Advancing Border Connectivity project will focus Route (SR) 11/Otay Mesa East Port of Entry (OME POE) and the Border Mobility Hub. The Next Operating System (OS) concepts will include the design and implementation of the Regional Border Management System (RBMS) for the new port of entry and connected vehicle technologies through the deployment of a Smart Intersection System (SIS) within the Mobility Hubs and corridors that connect them. The project deploys technologies that will make it safe and easy for people and goods to travel to, from, and around the border region. The partnership includes SANDAG, Caltrans, the cities of San Diego, Chula Vista, National City, the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System (MTS), and the Port of San Diego.
