








# LACCD Portfolio of Facilites



# BuildLACCD LSEDV Program

- Intended to contribute to the economic development of the community through the inclusion of **local**, **small**, **emerging and disabled veteran-owned** businesses (LSEDV).
- Contractor performance on local hire and community engagement goals is and reflected in the proposal scoring process for large LACCD projects.
- Partner with minority, women, LGBTQ and other community-based trade organizations to promote equitable contracting opportunities.
- Small Contractor Boot Camp and educational webinars are offered to learn how to do business with LACCD.





# LSEDV Program continued

- Pre-Qualified Service Projects (PQSP) specifically for "smaller" General and/or Specialty Contractors (Projects valued \$25K - \$5M)
- Points are awarded on pre-qualifications and proposal to firms holding LSEDV certifications from a Federal agency or by any public certifying agency in California
- CED staff available for one-on-one meetings to identify bond program and LSEDV opportunities
