

Sites Reservoir Project A \$3.9 Billion Project Coming Soon to the Sacramento Valley

- The Sites Project Authority could utilize DBB or CMAR delivery methods for the upcoming \$3.9 Billion dollars of construction.
- Additional Procurement Packages CMAR for the major conveyance package of the project (Pump Stations, Pipelines, Electrical distribution) ... value of \$1.2B- PDB/O for mitigation land development for an estimated construction value of \$600M.
- Procurement will include a CMAR package for the major civil works of the project (Dams, Roads, and Bridge) for an estimated construction value of \$1.8B.
- Future potential packages may also include DBB or CMAR for an additional \$2.1B of work.

Sites Reservoir, located below the existing reservoirs in the Sacramento Valley, will increase the resiliency of water supplies since it will not rely on spring snowmelt for filling but instead will capture storm-related runoff and a portion of storm-related flood water. Operating in conjunction with other California reservoirs, Sites Reservoir will substantially increase water supply flexibility, reliability, and resiliency in drier years. Sites Reservoir will help with statewide operational effectiveness of the State Water Project and Central Valley Project. The Sites Project Authority will build and operate a climate-resilient, 21st Century water storage system to responsibly manage and deliver water, improve the environment, provide flood control and recreational benefits. Additionally, it will provide affordable water for California's farms and cities for generations to come.
