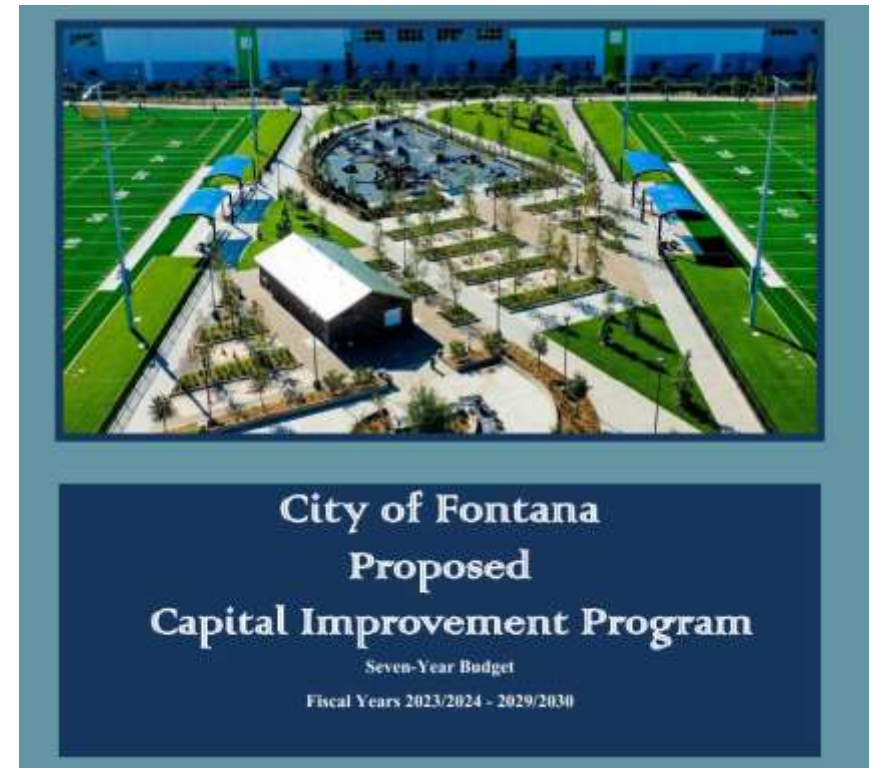

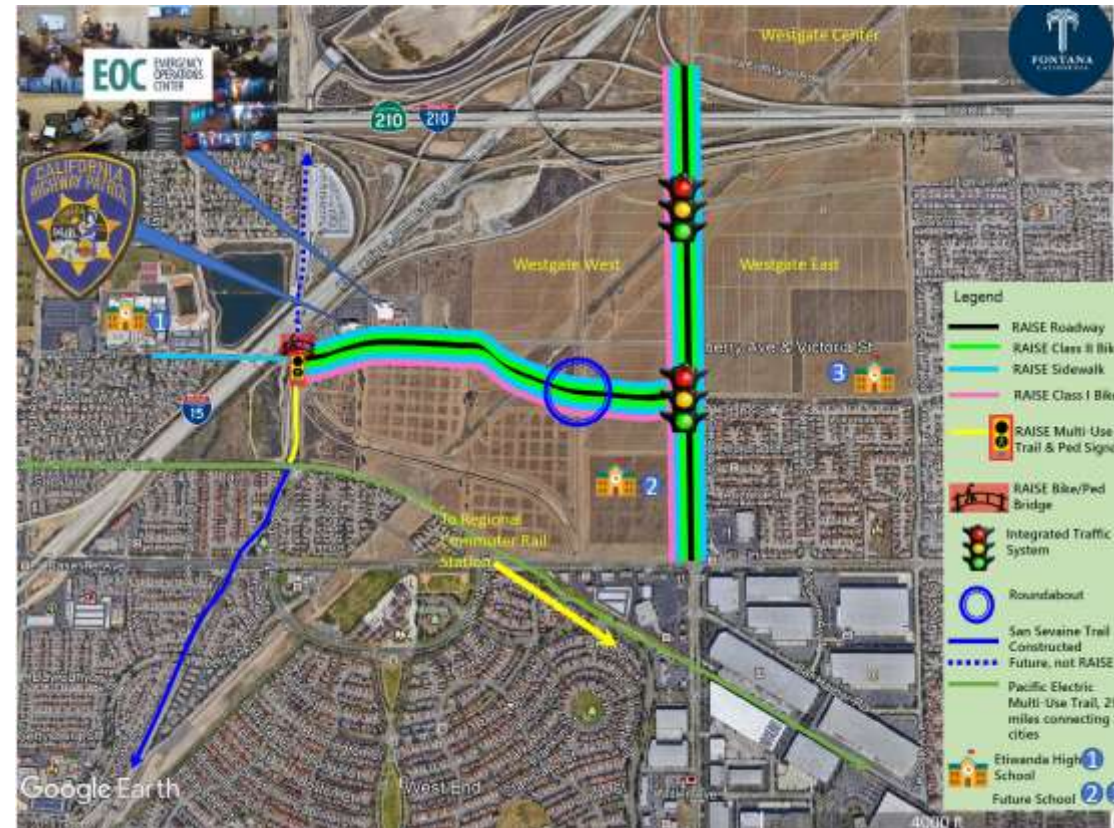
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Westgate Infrastructure Improvement Project

- **Project Description:** Complete streets improvements, including street widening, integrated traffic system, roundabout, and raised medians. The project scope also includes Class I bike trails, sidewalks. The project limits are Victoria Street between I-15/Cherry Avenue Interchange and Cherry Avenue and Cherry Avenue between SR-210 and Baseline Road.
- **Status:** In-Design & Environmental Phase
- **Construction Cost:** \$29.6M (**\$15M RAISE Grant**)
- **Construction Start:** Fall 2025
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Construction
 - Inspection
 - Construction Management



Foothill Blvd Widening Project (Malaga Bridge)



- **Project Description:** Safety enhancement with complete infrastructure improvements along Foothill Blvd (part of historic Route 66). The project also includes bridge replacement, storm drain improvements, bike lanes, ADA-compliant sidewalks and ramps, and updated signage
- **Status:** Design & Environmental Phase
- **Construction Cost:** \$27M (\$19.8M SS4A Grant)
- **Construction Start:** Fall 2027
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Construction
 - Inspection
 - Construction Management



Fire Station #80 Training Center

- **Project Description:** 4,193 SF Training Center, and 7,000 SF Training Tower in 2.2 acre site
- **Status:** Design & Environmental Phase
- **Construction Cost:** \$12M
- **Construction Start:** Early 2025
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Construction

City Hall Renovation Project – Phase II (City Hall)

- **Project Description:** Demolition of existing City Hall Building and Council Chambers and construction of new two-story combined office space, parking structure and council chambers.
- **Project Delivery Method:** Design-Bid-Build
- **Status:** Design
- **Construction Cost:** \$40M
- **Construction Start:** In 2025
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Construction
 - Construction Management





Downtown West Parking Structure Project

- **Description:** Demolition of existing commercial buildings and construction of a new parking structure (Min. 400 Parking Spaces)
- **Project Delivery Method:** Design-Build
- **Status:** RFQ for Design-Build Entities closed. RFP to be issued shortly
- **Construction Cost:** \$15M
- **Construction Start:** Fall 2025
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Construction Management



First Responders (9/11) Memorial Monument

- **Description:** Construction of a monument within the City Hall campus incorporating a 18' long beam from the World Trade Center debris.
- **Status:** Design Phase in progress
- **Construction Cost:** \$2M
- **Construction Start:** Late 2024
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Construction






Fontana Art Gallery/Children's Museum

- **Description:** Construction of a two-story combined Art Gallery (1st floor) and Children's Museum (2nd floor). Each floor will be approximately 6,000 SF.
- **Project Delivery Method:** Conventional Design-Bid-Build
- **Status:** Architecture Design RFP to be issued in near future
- **Construction Cost:** TBD
- **Construction Start:** TBD
- **Contract opportunities:**
 - Architectural/Engineering
 - Construction
