NCTD CIP Overview

- The NCTD Capital Improvement Program (CIP) incorporates NCTD's current and future capital needs and is updated annually
- Initial annual CIP approval by NCTD Board of Directors in December or January; final CIP included in the fiscal year budget approved in June
- Submitted to the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) for approval and incorporated into the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) and, subsequently, in the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP)



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NCTD Strategic Priorities

- Grow Ridership and Improve Service Quality
 - Advance projects that can be implemented quickly to enhance the customer riding experience
 - Improve SPRINTER fleet reliability and availability
 - Enhance safety and security resources on revenue vehicles and at facilities

 Fund and Successfully Implement State-of-Good-Repair and Priority Capital Needs

- Secure funding for key San Diego Subdivision and Escondido Subdivision improvements
- Develop funding strategy to implement priority projects from BREEZE Speed and Reliability Study
- Advance the delivery of projects and improve project reporting
