ADOPTED BY METROPOLITAN'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS IN OCTOBER 2022 FOR AN INITIAL 5 YEAR TERM

60% GOAL FOR EMPLOYING LOCAL WORKERS

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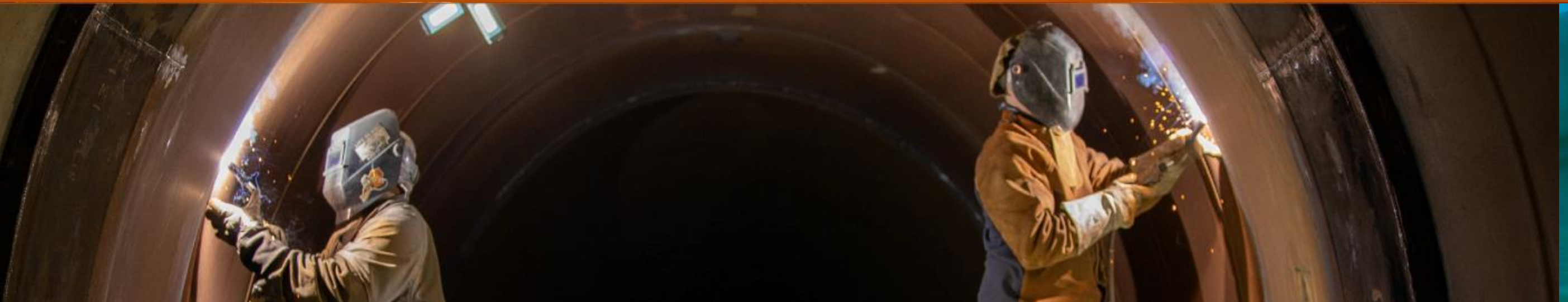
