Established to ensure that small businesses have every opportunity to do business with the Airport Authority

MISSION

Build relationships between the Airport Authority and the small business community by providing valuable resources that exceed expectations and increase diversity







Why We Do It

- Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program
 - 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 23
 - Overall Triennial DBE Goal
- Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Program
 - 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 26
 - Overall ACDBE Non-Car Rental Goal
 - Overall ACDBE Car Rental Goal
- Economic and Community Contributions









Inclusionary Approach

- Successful method to maximize opportunities for Small, Local and Veteran Owned Small Businesses (including disabled)
- Subcontracting opportunities exist, but not clearly defined
- Prime contractors required to submit to Authority:
 - Monthly reporting of achievements to Small Business Development
 - Outreach Plan to include key points but not limited to these six areas:







Policy 5.12

- Authority's policy allowing preference to Small Businesses (SB), Veteran Owned Small Businesses (VOSB) including disabled, and Local Business Enterprises (LBE) in the award of Authority contracts
- Preference for meeting SB, VOSB, and/LB goal(s)
- Does not apply to federally funded projects
- Maximum \$200,00 or 7%

PRIME

- No quantifiable subcontracting opportunities
- Preference if meets any three business classifications





- Subcontracting opportunities
- Goals for SB, LB and VOSB
- Goal(s) must be met to receive preference







Policy 5.12

Authority's Small Business (SB) definition:

- Enrolled in Authority's Bonding & Contract Financing Assistance Program, or
- Certified as DBE/ACDBE by California Unified Certification Program, or
- Possess valid certification issued by agency approved by Authority; agency verifies firm meets Small Business Administration (SBA) size standards


Authority's Veteran Owned Small Business (VOSB) definition:

 A certified veteran-owned or service-disabled veteran-owned small business or veteran (including disabled) business enterprise that meets the Authority's Small Business definition in this policy

A LOCAL BUSINESS IS DEFINED AS ONE THAT MEETS THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:






Local Business Submission on Authority Vendor Portal



Certifications Administered by the Authority

- Small Business Development administers and processes the following certifications:
 - Local Business Enterprise (LBE)
 - Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE)
 - Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)
- The Authority is a certifying member of California Unified Certification Program (CUCP) to certify firms as ACDBEs and DBEs pursuing contracts with SAN

(*DBEs working on FTA and FHWA assisted projects are subject to both SBA size and DBE statutory gross receipt standards)		
Meets ACDBE size standard: firm's 5 years gross annual receipts does not exceed SBA's size standard of \$56.42 million		х
