- 5,000 transfers to 4-year universities


Since 2017, LACCD has enrolled students through LA College Promise.



BuildLACCD LSEDV Program

- Intended to contribute to the economic development of the community through the inclusion of local, small, emerging and disabled veteran-owned businesses (LSEDV)
- Contractor performance on local hire and community engagement goals is included in the proposal scoring process for large LACCD projects
- Partner with minority, women, LGBTQ and other community-based trade organizations to promote equitable contracting opportunities
- Small Contractor Boot Camp and educational webinars are offered to learn how to do business with LACCD





LSEDV Program continued

- Pre-Qualified Service Program (PQSP) specifically for "smaller" General and/or Specialty Contractors (Projects valued \$25K - \$5M)
- **Points are awarded** on pre-qualifications and proposal **to firms holding LSEDV certifications** from a Federal agency or by any public certifying agency in California
- **CED staff available for one-on-one meetings** to identify bond program and LSEDV opportunities





SMALL CONTRACTOR BOOT CAMP (Bi-Annual)

Spring 2025 Small Contractor Boot Camp

The Los Angeles Community College District's (LACCD) Small Contractor Boot Camp is a foursession program explicitly designed for small contractors to improve their competitive bidding capacity. Through a comprehensive curriculum, small contractors will learn more about the prequalification process for the BuildLACCD Program's Pre-Qualified Service Provider (PQSP) bench, for projects ranging from \$25K - \$5M.

HYBRID SCHEDULE



LACCD's \$15.04 billion building program seeks to modernize and renovate projects throughout its nine colleges. The Board of Trustees established a 30% Local, Small, Emerging, and Disabled Veteran (LSEDV) participation goal for all BuildLACCD contracts. This provides numerous opportunities for LSEDV businesses to participate in the program.
