#### **Program Activities: First Four Years**

- Phase I Project Development | Now June 2025

  - Design-Build team awards | August January 2026

- Phase II Project Development | 2027 2031
  - Develop RFPs for Phase I Design-Build teams | 2028
  - Advertise and selection process for Design-Build teams | 2028
  - Design-Build team awards | 2029

### **Community Benefits Agreement (CBA)**

SDCCD's Community Benefits Agreement (CBA) applies to all future large-scale construction contracts valued at \$1M or higher.

- Initial Employment Preferences
  - Residents of qualifying ZIP codes designated in the CBA
  - Veterans residing anywhere
- Craft Hour Allocation
  - At least 80% of all craft hours must be performed by the following:
  - Residents of San Diego County
  - Dependents of active-duty military personnel
  - Current or former students of SDCCD (including those enrolled in online programs)
- Support for SDCCD Apprentice and Academic Programs

#### What Builders Need to Know About Doing Business with the SDCCD

#### **Contractor Registration**

Register and complete the contractor prequalification section on the SDCCD PlanetBids Vendor Portal to be notified about bid and RFP/RFQ opportunities and be included on the District's Informal Bidders List for contracts up to \$220,000.



#### Prequalification

To be prequalified for opportunities estimated at \$220,000 and up, please complete the appropriate prequalification form - \$220,000 – 999,999K or \$1M and up - located in the **Contractor Prequalification** section at: https://www.sdccd.edu/departments/operations/Bid-and-Contract-<u>Opportunities.aspx</u>. Contractors approved for \$1M and up **do not** have to complete any other applications, as they will be prequalified for all District projects. Contracts for under \$220,000 do not require the completion of a supplemental prequalification packet. However, PlanetBids registration, including the online contractor pregualification section, is still required.
