








STUDENTS

CSU students are largely from California, and most remain in the state after graduation, applying the skills and knowledge they have learned to help the Golden State's economy thrive.










- Half of CSU students are URM

Americans with a college degree earned it at the CSU




employees in California is a CSU graduate



network is larger than the population of 23 U.S. states


