We are a multi-disciplined department of professionals from many backgrounds, providing comprehensive project management services for existing buildings, and ground-up construction.




Strategic Team Alignment: Serving Customers with Focused Expertise


PMD ORGANIZATION CHART FY 25/26

Funding Ready Package (FRP)

CIP Request – Departments can submit requests through the portal, track real-time status updates, view assigned SPM and PM, check submittal dates, and access a copy of the FRP.


Scoping – Site walks with inspectors and clients ensure a thoroughly developed **Detailed Scope of Work (DSOW)**, minimizing the risk of missed scopes.


Estimation – Estimators participate in site walks to develop precise cost estimates, reducing risks of underor over-budgeting.

Scheduling – A detailed project timeline is included in the FRP, providing clients with clear visibility on project milestones and deadlines.

Delivery – The approved package is delivered to the client and uploaded into the **CIP portal** for easy reference and tracking.

Pioneering Digital Transformation with SBC Inspect


