- passenger loading bridges

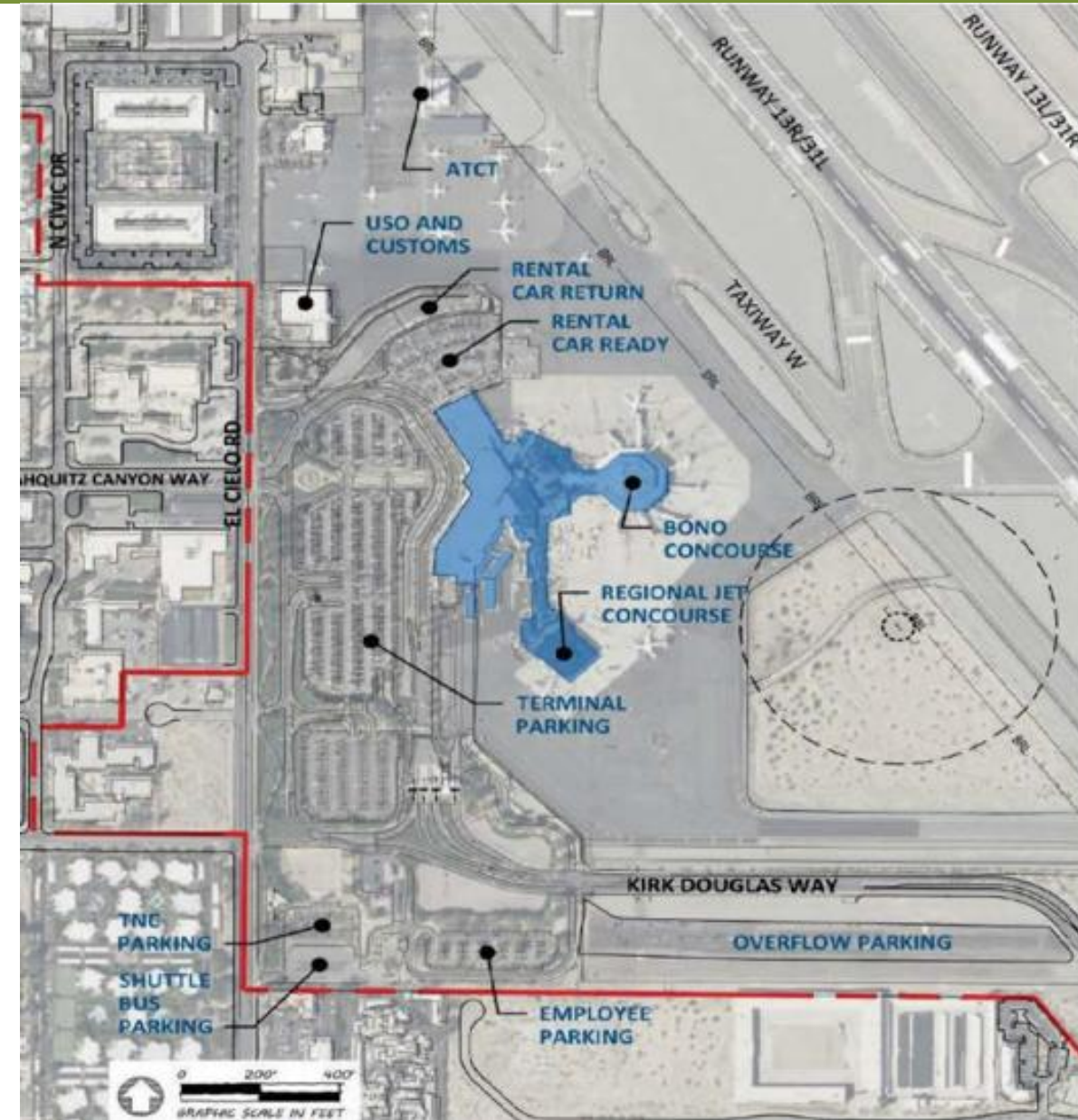
Agua Caliente Concourse

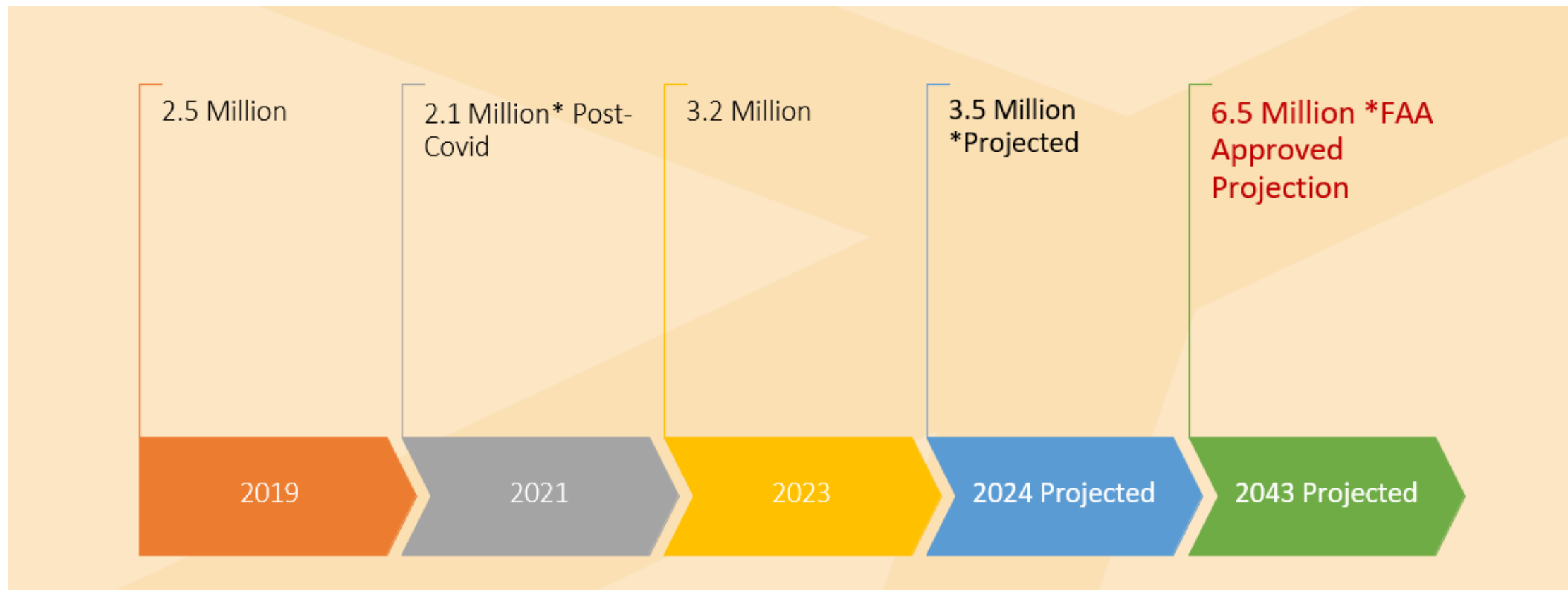


GENERAL INFORMATION

TOTAL ANNUAL PASSENGERS:



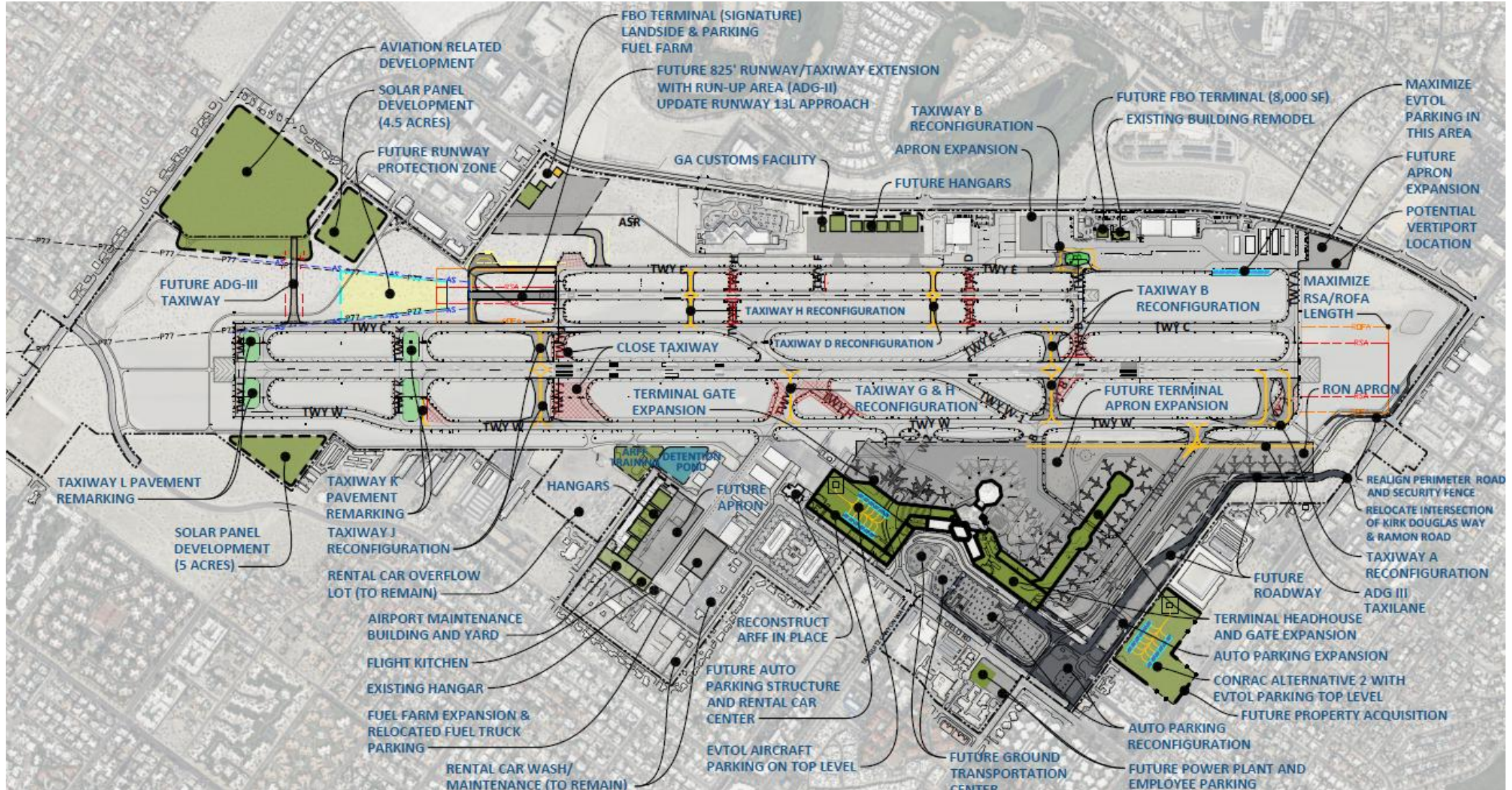
CURRENT PROJECTS

Airport Master Plan – Maximizing use of existing facilities

- Kicked off in March 2023
- Conceptual Development plan approved by City in January 2025
- CEQA/NEPA Process expected to take 18-24 months
- Planning study identifies three phases of construction over the next 20 years
- Total programmatic costs approaching **\$3 Billion** in development

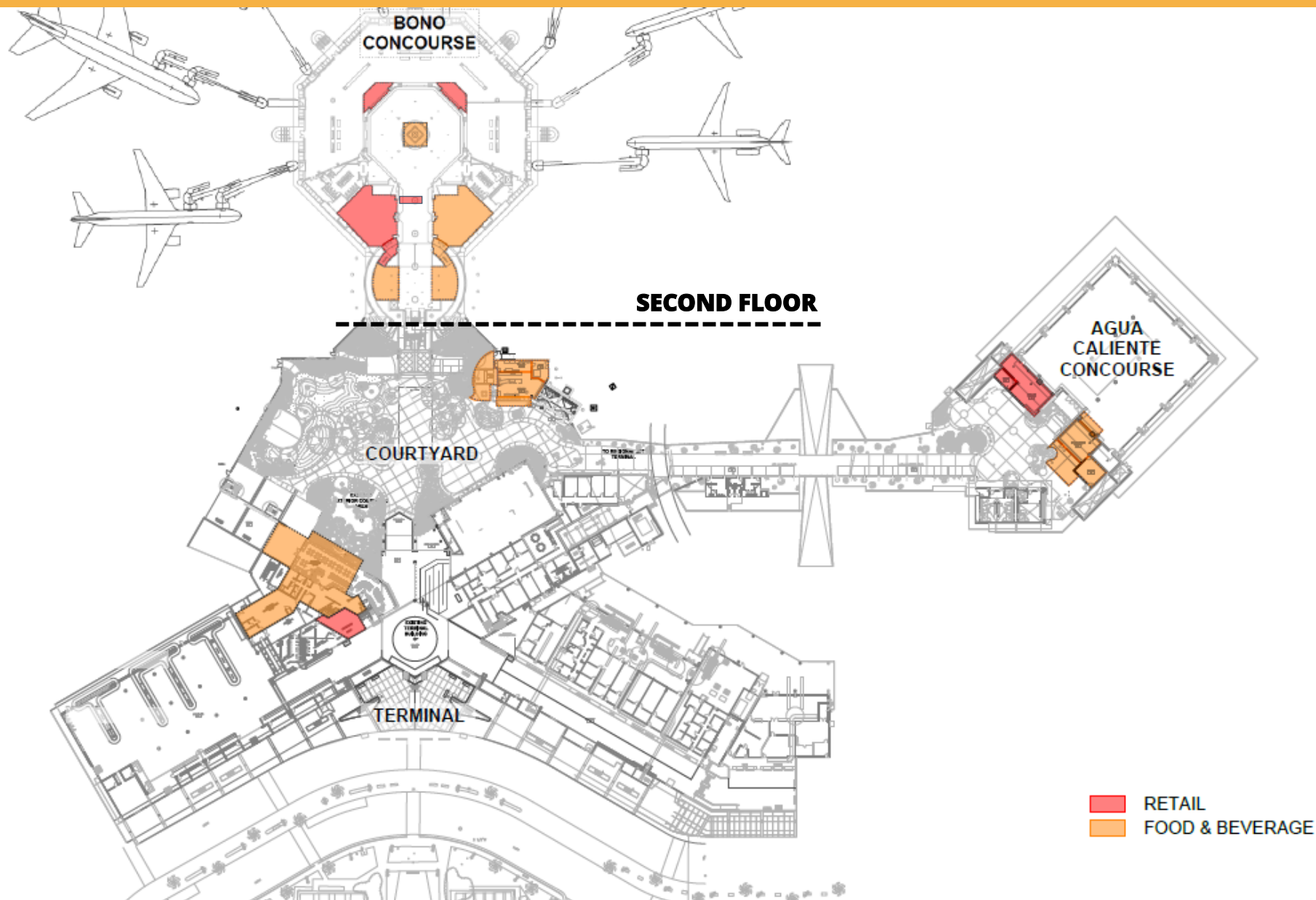

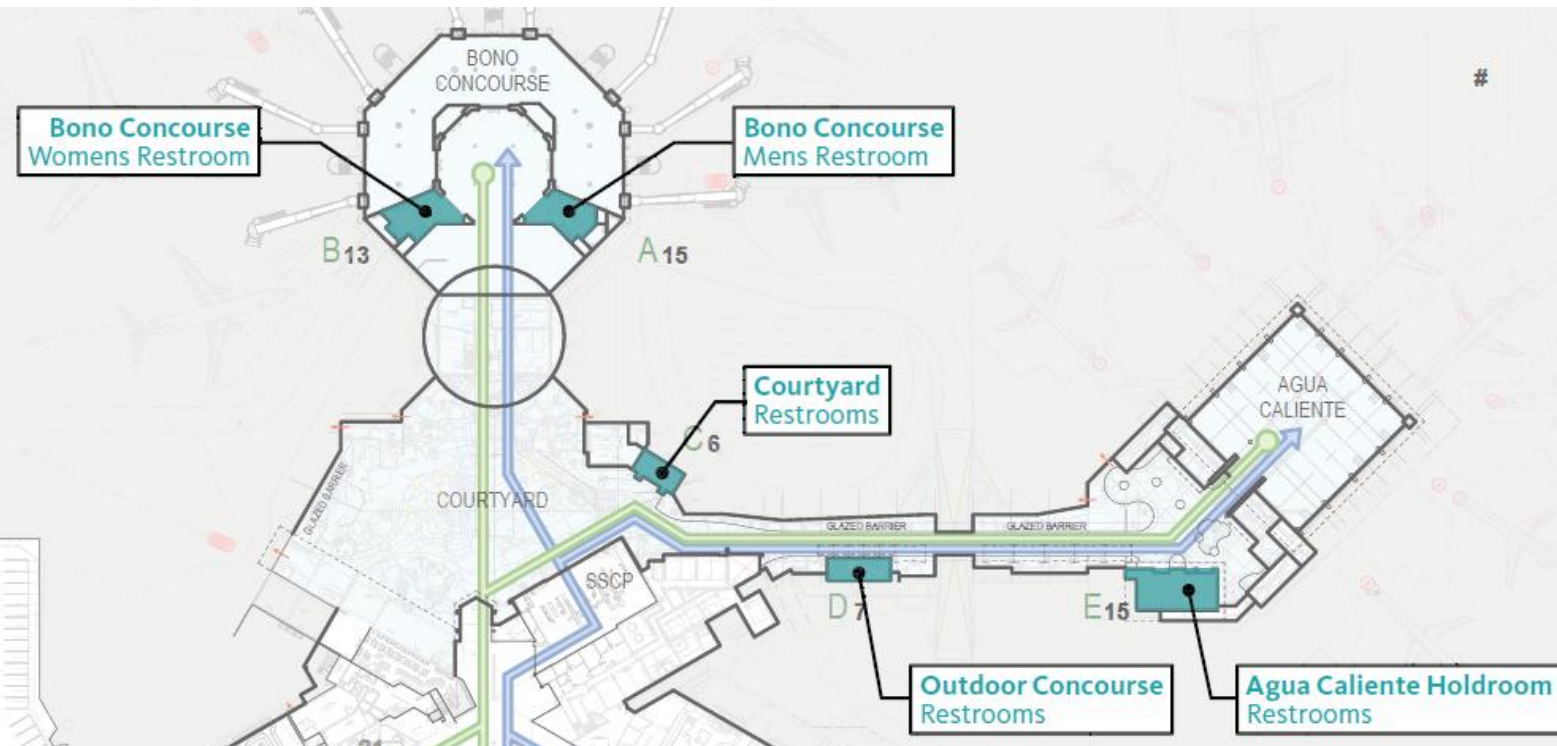

Beginning: Fall 2026 through Fall of 2023

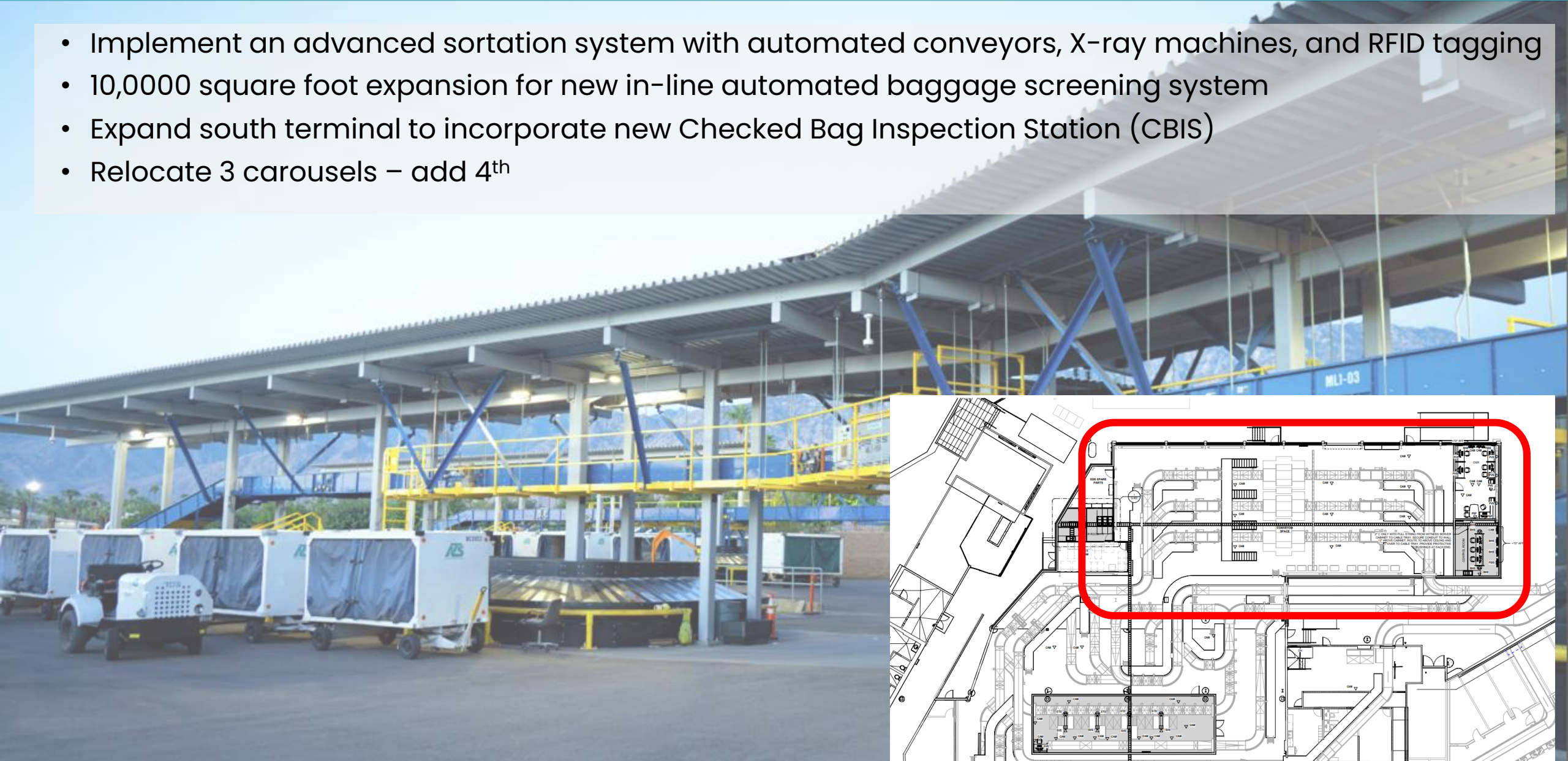

UPCOMING PROJECTS

OUTBOUND BAGGAGE HANDLING SYSTEM

- Implement an advanced sortation system with automated conveyors, X-ray machines, and RFID tagging
- 10,000 square foot expansion for new in-line automated baggage screening system
- Expand south terminal to incorporate new Checked Bag Inspection Station (CBIS)
- Relocate 3 carousels – add 4th



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- Phase 1 Kicked off in October 2023
 - Phase 2 Feasibility Study – Completed Sept 2024
 - Informs strategy for CBP officer allocation
 - Market study suggests opportunities and demand for International service from south of the border and possibly Western Europe
