

Major and Minor Capital Project Definitions

- The University of California (UC) defines a major capital project as a construction or improvement project with an estimated cost of more than \$1,000,000. The Chancellor, President or Regents grant approval for major capital projects. Projects that cost more than \$10,000,000 have additional requirements.
- The UC Office of the President (UCOP) also defines minor capital projects, which have an estimated cost between \$35,000 and \$1,000,000. The Executive Vice Chancellor approves minor capital projects.



Since 1990, UCLA has invested more than \$2.97 billion to retrofit (80) buildings totaling over 12.8 million gross square feet.







Certification: 66 completed building certifications and 23 buildings in process with the Green Business Certification Program, UCLA has been a demonstrative leader in building performance.

UCLA's first certification was in 2006, and as of September 2024, The Campus has completed 66 LEED buildings, (18) of which are the highest Platinum level, making it the 2nd largest LEED portfolio in CA behind the Irvine Company.

UCLA has set a high standard for its new construction projects, guaranteeing sustainability will be at its core.

UCLA has also been very proactive in its commitment to sustainable procurement, reflected in their earning of 54 Los Angeles Green Business certifications.
