




# Prioritization Criteria for Projects



#### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

Creates a safer and healthier community for everyone



#### **EXISTING CONDITIONS**

Addresses issues with County property and reduces future repair costs



#### **COLLABORATION**

Driven by communities and/or involves community groups or other agencies



#### **ENVIRONMENT**

Prepares for climate change and improves air and water quality



#### REQUIRED WORK

Address and meets the County, State, and Federal codes and regulations



#### **IMPROVEMENT**

Builds or upgrades County facilities (streets. sidewalks, lights, etc.)



#### **ECONOMY**

Helps local business thrive and improves access to opportunities



#### **PROJECT READINESS**

me work has been planned and/or started

**EQUITY** is also considered by identifying projects that address disparities within the Health/Safety, Existing Conditions, Economy, Environment, Improvement and Collaboration factors. These subfactors vary within Capital Assets as appropriate.



#### **CIP Projects**

This map displays projects that are currently funded or partially funded as part of the CIP. Each year DPW reviews and revises our forecast of planned and potential capital projects, the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). The CIP spans a five-year timeline and ensures that we take care of aging infrastructure in a way that is aligned with the County's Strategic Initiatives. We will be compiling suggestions received from the public and stakeholders on community needs as part of this public outreach process.





- Green infrastructure to remove pollution and improve water quality



### Want to bid on Contracts?

The County of San Diego's procurement website is where the Department of Public Works posts bidding opportunities for capital improvement projects.

#### How to Bid:

- 1. Register for an account on the SDBuyNet website
- 2. Search for current bid opportunities related to capital improvement projects
- 3. Review the bid documents and project specifications
- 4. Submit your bid proposal by the deadline

#### **Key Considerations:**

- Bidding process and requirements are governed by the County's procurement policies
- Contracts are typically awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder
- Successful bidders must comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and insurance/bonding requirements
