



Delivery Methods



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There are four main construction project delivery options used in SAUSD:

- Design-Bid-Build (Formal Bidding or "hard bid")
- Construction Management Multi-Prime (CMMP)
- Design-Build (One Entity)
- Lease-Leaseback ("LLB")






- I-18: Most projects complete or in progress




