The **San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency (SGPWA)** was established in 1961 by the California State Legislature. The Agency boundaries extend through Calimesa, Beaumont, Banning and Cabazon.

The Agency is one of 29 State Water Contractors. Each Contractor is responsible for importing water from Northern California through the State Water Project (California aqueduct) into their service area. [Click here to learn more about State Water Contractors.](#)

The **Delta Conveyance Project** will modernize water infrastructure in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta by making physical improvements to how we capture and move water during wet years for use in dry years with a tunnel system. The Delta Conveyance Project is intended to restore the reliability of the State Water Project and ensure California's largest supply of clean and affordable water for 27 million people and 750,000 acres of farmland is protected from earthquakes and climate-driven weather extremes.

Sites Reservoir will be an off stream storage facility that captures and stores stormwater flows in the Sacramento River for release in dry and critical years for environmental use and for California communities, farms and businesses when it is so desperately needed.
