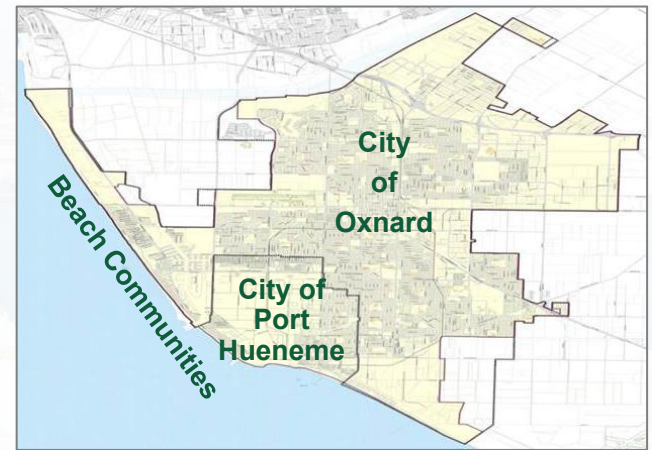

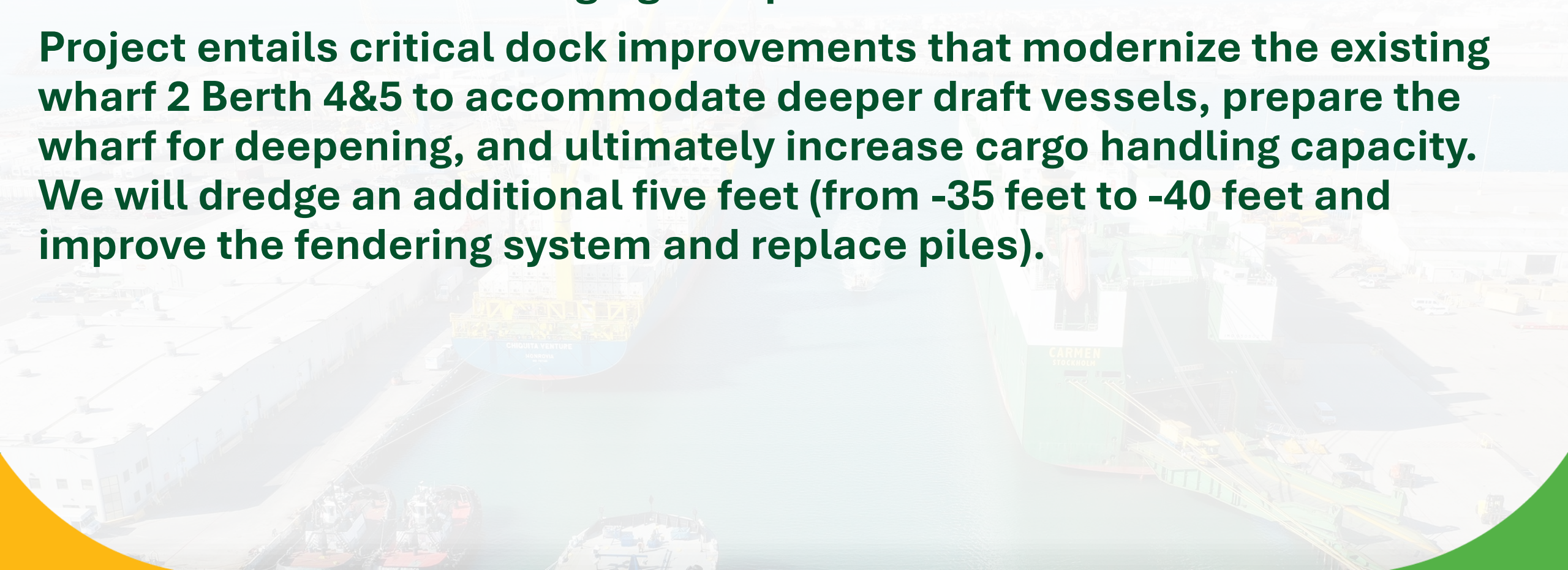


Upcoming Capital Improvement Projects



- Wharf 2 Berths 4&5 Dredging & Improvements

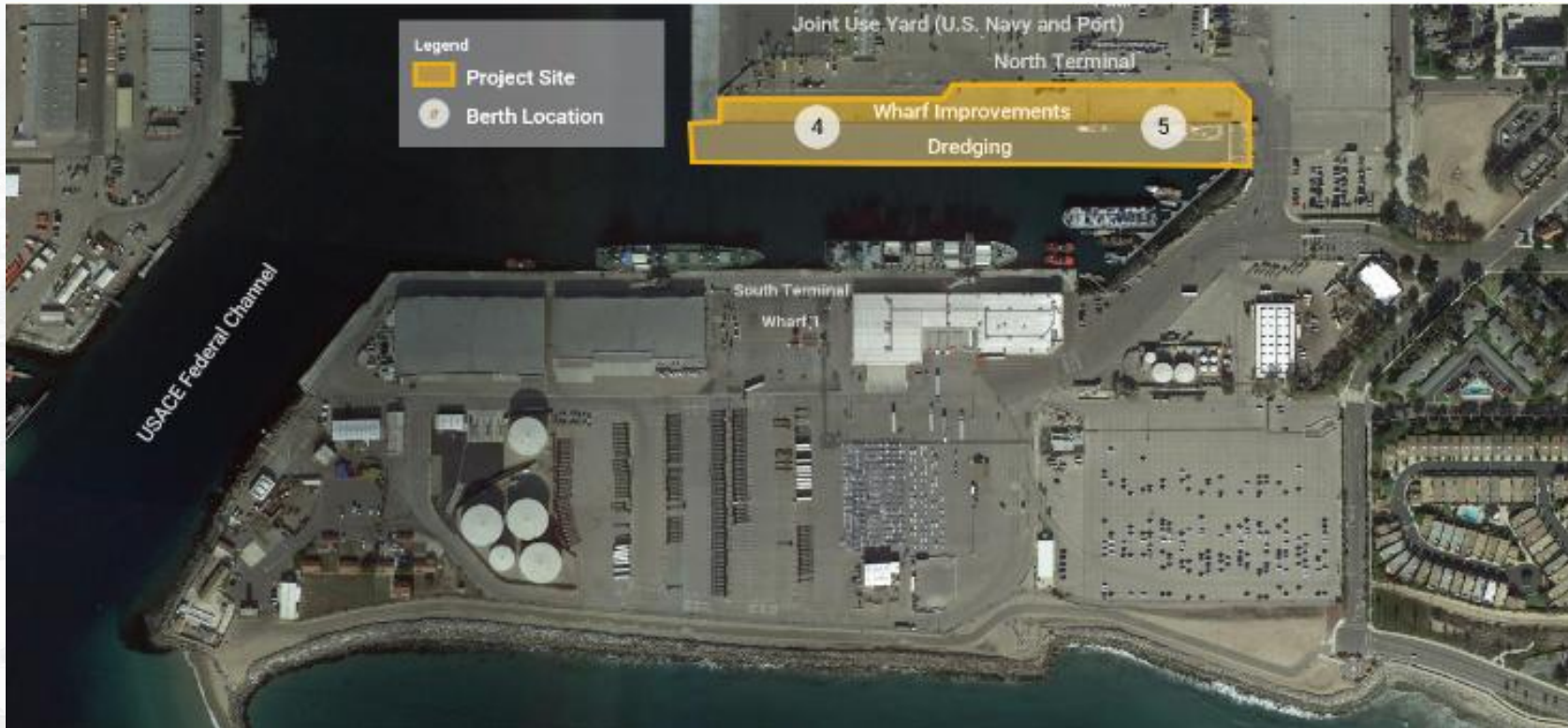
Project entails critical dock improvements that modernize the existing wharf 2 Berth 4&5 to accommodate deeper draft vessels, prepare the wharf for deepening, and ultimately increase cargo handling capacity. We will dredge an additional five feet (from -35 feet to -40 feet and improve the fendering system and replace piles).

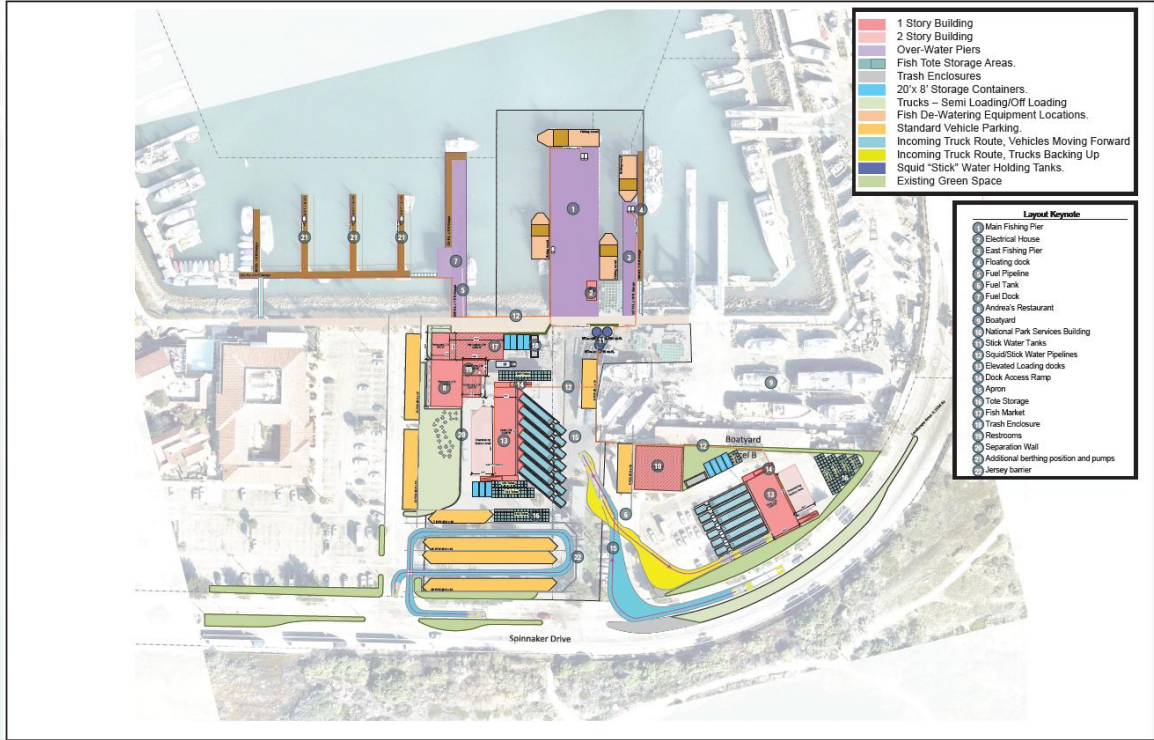

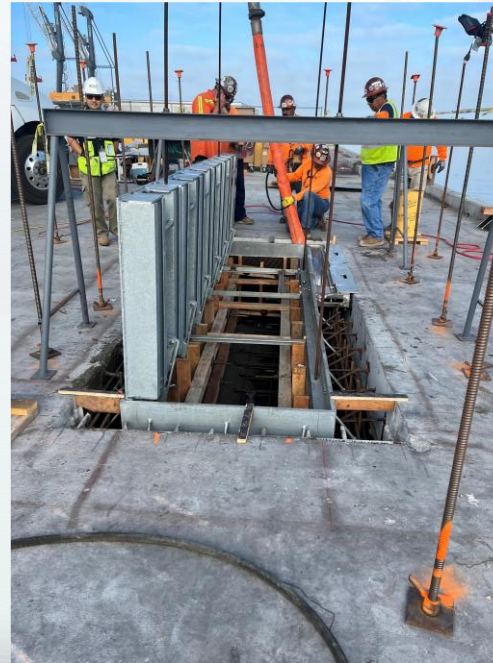
- E-Crane Expansion Project

Construction of infrastructure needed to add four additional crane vaults at Wharf 1 to support the hybrid cranes at the Port.

- Del Monte Demolition

Demolition of an existing refrigerated building, that will include electrical power re-feed, slurry wall/secant wall along Wharf 1 and installation of high mast lights.

Upcoming Capital Improvement Projects



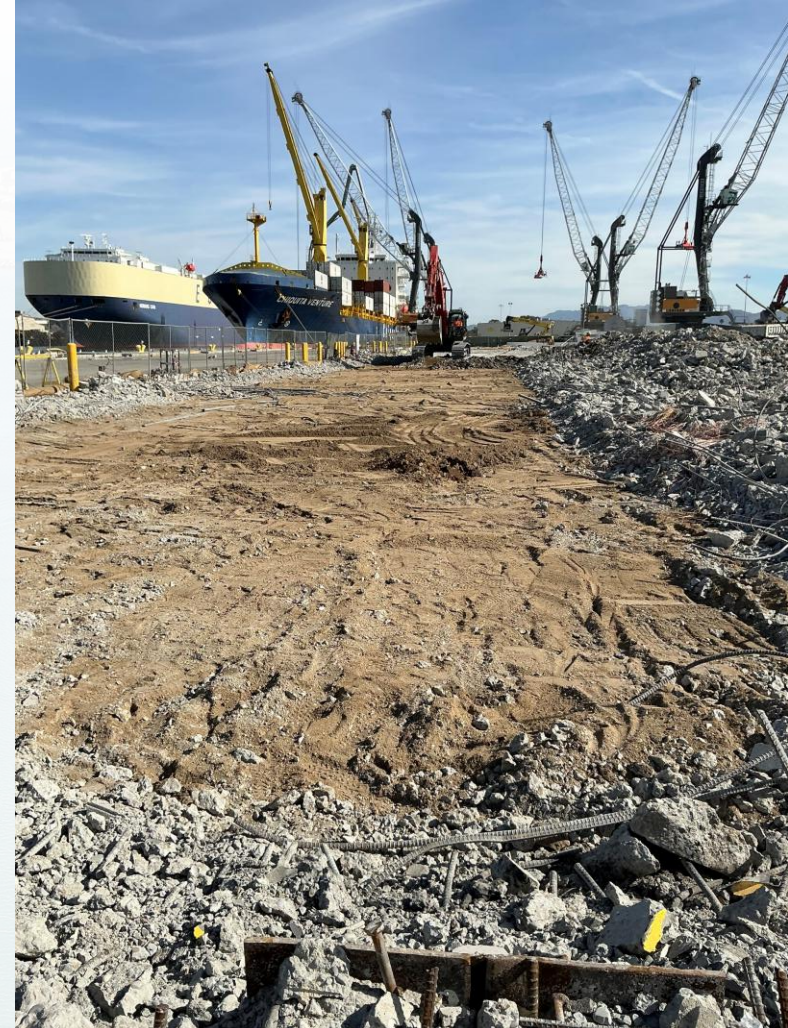
- Under Wharf Waterline Replacement

Relocation of approximately 1600ft of 10” water line under the dock that will include new portable water and fire hydrants.

Installation of charging units to support the deployment of battery-electric cargo handling equipment.
